

Directions to Crystal Water Farm:

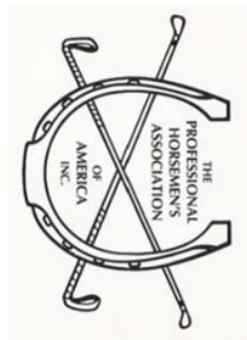
From Route 84, take exit 4E for Route 17 East. Continue on 17 east to exit 124 (Florida), turn left at end of ramp onto Route 17A. Continue approximately 5-6 miles into the town of Florida. Turn right at second light in Florida onto Bridge Street. Follow main road with double yellow lines 4.5 miles. Crystal Water Farm (Union Corners Road) will be on your right.

From South, take Route 94 North. Turn left onto Route 1A (Ochs Apple Orchard directly across on the right). Go through stoplight and first blinking light; turn right at second blinking light (third light-Pine Island Turnpike). Bear left at fork onto Union Corners Road, Crystal Water Farm will be on your left approximately 1/4 mile down.

From NYS Thruway, take exit 16. Continue on Route 17 West. Take exit 126; go left at end of ramp onto Route 94 South. Go approximately 5 miles to next traffic light; turn left (still Route 94 South). Continue to next traffic light at end of town; turn right onto Bridge Street. Follow main road with double yellow lines 4.5 miles. Crystal Water Farm (Union Corners Road) will be on your right.

Evening Series High Score Awards

1. High score awards will be given for the horse or rider earning the most points in each division.
 2. Exhibitors must participate in at least three shows to be eligible for high score awards.
 3. Points earned during the last show of the series on August 17th will be doubled for the series end awards.
 4. Management reserves the right to add, combine, or delete classes at their discretion.
 5. Entry Fees \$20.00 per class, \$25 for WHVPHA classes, \$35.00 for medals and classics
 6. Classes labeled WHVPHA count for WHVPHA points on 6/29 only. Except for class 17, WHVPHA fence classes will be regular division Handy Hunter classes at subsequent shows. Class 17 will be held on the 6/29 show only.
 7. Tests for Handy Hunter classes to include any 3 of the following and will be appropriate for each level: Rollback, Trot fence or leap-over, Handgallop a fence, Bending line, End fence, Open a gate, Option fence
 8. Trotting on course not penalized for all 2' hunter classes.
 9. All shows will follow the guidelines of the USEF except where otherwise specified.
 10. Classics must have 3 entries in order to be held.
 11. Must enter at least one full division to be eligible to enter M&S classes.
 12. Classics must be entered before the start of the corresponding division.
 13. Champion and Reserve in all divisions. All classes will be held in the sand ring.
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
