Additional Rules

1. Entry fees \$20.00 per class; \$45 for M&S Pony Jumper Classic; \$35.00 for other M&S classes
2. Trophy and six ribbons in each class. Minimum of two entries for points to count toward high score awards.
3. Classes to be split if entries warrant.
4. Management reserves the right to add or delete classes at their discretion.
5. Third fences class for each Hunter division will be a Handy Hunter class.
6. Tests to include any 3 of the following and will be appropriate for each level: Rollback, Trot fence or leap-over, Handgallop a fence, Bending line, End fence, Open a gate, Option fence
7. Champion and Reserve Ribbons in each division. Points to be awarded: 1st – 10; 2nd – 6; 3rd – 4; 4th – 2; 5th – 1; 6th – ½.
8. All shows will follow the guidelines of USEF rules except where otherwise specified.
9. Classics must have 3 entries in order to be held.
10. Must enter at least one full division to be eligible to enter M&S hunter classics.
11. Classics must be entered before the start of the corresponding division.
12. Second class of hunter divisions is the first round of corresponding M&S Hunter Classic.
13. M&S Hunter Classic second round to follow the last class in the division at the appropriate height.
14. Classes 8-14 will be divided Junior/Senior if entries warrant.
